### NOTICE

Indian Council of Philosophical Research, New Delhi invites proposals in the prescribed format (available at <http://www.icpr.in/forms.html> ) from Departments of Philosophy and also from **scholars (Gen/SC/ST category wise)** affiliated with Universities, Colleges and Academic Institutions from the **North East Region of the country** for getting financial assistance for the following programme :

**1. SEMINAR/SYMPOSIA WORKSHOPS/DIALOGUE** - In order to provide an opportunity for scholars to express their views and interact with other scholars, ICPR invites application from philosophy departments and research institutions from north eastern region for national and international seminars on a variety of themes and topics in philosophy and interdisciplinary studies. It also gives grant to organize seminars/symposia/ workshops/dialogues etc.

**2. REFRESHER COURSES** - The Council provides financial assistance in organizing Refresher Courses on different philosophical themes for the college and university of the north east region of the country. The aim of these courses is providing an opportunity to the teaching staff and scholars to augment and refresh their knowledge. These courses may be up to 3-tier courses, viz. as initial, intermediate and advanced courses.

**3. PROJECTS GRANTS** - ICPR invites application for the Project Grants in following categories :

1.	SHORT DURATION PROJECT	0.20 Lakh	3 Months
2.	MINOR PROJECT	0.5 to 2 Lakh	1 Year
3.	MAJOR PROJECT	2 - 10 lakh	2 - 5 Years
4.	TRANSLATION PROJECT	Rs. 200/- Per Page and Rs 25,000 as Contingency grant	1- 2 Years

**4. TRAVEL GRANTS** - The Council invites application for partial travel assistance (for abroad) to Indian scholars in the field of philosophy and interdisciplinary studies for participating in international conferences/symposia/seminars etc. Normally, the financial assistance is limited to 50 percent of the total cost of airfare to and fro. This provision is made for teachers of philosophy in universities and colleges.

**5. BOOK GRANTS** - Council has initiated a scheme for providing book grants to promote research and teaching in Philosophy and allied disciplines. In this scheme ICPR provides its publications to various educational institutions including professional institutions where Philosophy is being taught or proposed to be taught and is not having philosophy books for the reference of the student/researchers.

The proposal applications in the prescribed format (available at <http://www.icpr.in/forms.html> ) and complete in all respects and forwarded through proper channel may be sent to undersigned till December 2011 for the academic year 2011-12. Advance proposal may also be sent for the academic year 2012-13.
